In such event, the above-mentioned warranty period shall apply to the medicines replaced from the date of the replacement thereof. Otherwise, the supplier shall pay to the purchaser such damages as may arise by reasons of the breach of the conditions herein on that behalf under this contract or otherwise. For substandard quality of medicines already consumed by the time that results are known, the supplier is liable to a penalty to the extent of the value of such items consumed which will be further determined at the sole discretion of the purchaser, in addition to any other penalty liable to be imposed under the relevant law.
